



**Purple Hands  
2007 Oregon Red Wine**

We're proud to offer for your consideration the third installment of our Oregon Red Wine blend. A new twist for 2007 is addition of Cabernet Franc to the starting lineup. This year's blend consists of:

**85% Merlot, 10% Pinot Noir, and 5% Cabernet Franc**

The Merlot and Cabernet Franc both come from Del Rio Vineyard in Southern Oregon's Rogue Valley, and the Pinot Noir is from Abbot Claim Vineyard in the Carlton Hills of the Willamette Valley. Both vineyards are some of the top sites in their respective AVAs. Aging is for 11 months in 100% French oak with 10% being new.

The 2007 hits the front palate with intense flavors of red berry and cherry(Pinot!). A weighty mid-palate transitions toward dark fruit, chocolate and earth.(Merlot! Cab Franc!) Silky tannins round out the long, lingering finish. (Oregon Red Wine!)

Purple Hands consists of two people; Cody Wright and Matt Giannone. We became friends while working a harvest together in Oregon, and produced our first vintage of PH in 2005. Starting Purple Hands has allowed us to make great wine which represents and respects the hands-on nature of small batch winemaking here in Oregon.

While we hope to add more wines in the future, the 2007 Oregon Red Wine blend is the one wine we have available for you. We made a limited production Pinot Noir from Canary Hill Vineyard in 2007. It is currently aging in bottle awaiting release in early 2009. It's delicious. We'll let you know when that comes out.
